

Should you have purchased a ticket with Air Europa that has subsequently been cancelled, you can postpone your departure date without incurring any change fees. You can book your new ticket with Air Europa in the 12 months following the original ticket's date of issue and fly in the 12 months after the new ticket's date of issue. In case your flight was expected to depart from 1 July 2020 onwards, you will need to book your new flight before the original departure date and the new flight should be scheduled to depart on or before 30 June 2021.

If you wish to book the same route, you will not be charged the difference in fares if the original flight departure date was on or before 30 June 2020. If original departure was on or after 1 July 2020, you may be required to pay the difference in price.

You can also book on any of the routes offered by Air Europa. In this case, you will need to pay the difference.

Irrespective of whether you book the same route or an alternative one, you will not incur any additional change fees.
